Book two of what will be a three part series, the LOST PRINCE by Selden Edwards is a must read. Like his first, The LITTLE BOOK, the author takes historical fact and weaves it into fiction. Many of the characters are real (Freud, Jung, Mahler, William James) and play an active, albeit made up role in the protagonist's life. The locations and events are also well researched and real.
